Public Works Committee Meeting

Meeting Minutes from December 11, 2006

1. The meeting was called to order by Jerry Pahl at 6:35 pm at the Village offices. Roll was taken:

2. The committee discussed the agenda. **Motion to approve the agenda by Berggren, seconded by Pahl. All were in favor, none opposed. Motion carried.**
3. The November 13, 2006 meeting minutes were reviewed. **Motion made to approve the minutes of November 13, 2006 as presented; by Kazik, seconded by Baranczyk. All were in favor, none opposed, Motion carried.**
4. Public Comments: None
5. Discussion on Jim Dunks drainage: Rick will check with Joe to see if Jim Dunk was sent a letter as indicated at our last meeting, that Mr. Dunk needs to work with Ashwaubenon for further action on the culvert replacement and Rick will report back at our next meeting.
6. Discussion/Action: Drainage, culvert cost Joe McCormick, Joe to send a Letter? Rick had no further information on this item, he will check with Joe to see if a letter was sent to Joe and will report back at the next meeting.
7. Discussion on Storm Water Utility (update): The Committee is continuing to meet and has the necessary ordinance 80% completed. Next meeting is December 12<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 PM. Meeting with the EPA last month went well. EPA is training a tribal member to act as its local inspector.
8. Discussion Village Bicycle Facility Plan: Discussion on the need to provide bicycle routes to our Four Seasons Park from our concentrated residential areas. Brown County has designated CTH J, CTH U, CTH F, CTH EB, and CTH EE as future bicycle facilities. The committee thought placing Trout Creek Rd, Part of N Overland between Trout Creek Rd and Four Seasons Park and all of N Pine Tree, including the future extension across STH 29 as the Village's future Bicycle Facilities Plan would provide the needed connections. **Motion was made by Berggren to recommend to the Village Board "that all of Trout Creek Rd, that part of N Overland Rd between Four Seasons Park and Trout Creek Rd, and all of N Pine Tree Rd including the future extension across STH 29, be designated as the Village's Bicycle Facility Plan for the future and be added to the Village's Comprehensive or Smart Growth Plan". Motion seconded by Baranczyk, all voted in favor, none opposed, Motion carried.**
9. Discussion on Five Year Road Plan: The Committee reviewed the Five Year Road Improvement Plan that was drafted last meeting and presented for further discussion. Even though the last two years were not filled completely, the Committee thought they should be left as is to see how the next year or two goes, perhaps getting some projects that will not be able to be funded in the first two years. The Committee felt that the improvements

proposed for each project appeared adequate and the costs are realistic. The Committee felt that the Draft Plan should be sent on to the Village Board as presented with some minor spelling corrections. **Motion was made by Pahl to send the Draft Plan on to the Board as presented (with minor spelling corrections) for adoption, motion was seconded by Baranczyk. All voted in favor, none opposed, Motion carried.** The Proposed Improvement Plan will be presented to the Village Board on the second meeting in January 2007 by Berggren.

10. Public Works Director Report: Rick Kinney

Work has continued on patching potholes. Rick is going to get together with Jerry Lancelle (Atlas Coordinator) and map out a winter road salting plan for various winter storms, ie- hills, curves, stop signs, and shaded areas.
