1. **CALL TO ORDER; ROLL CALL:** Meeting was called to order by Keith Sowinski at 6:30 pm. Present were Keith Sowinski, Dave Baranczyk, Don Dahlstrom, David Smith, Ed Kazik, Richard Happel. Excused: Dan DeRuyter, Tim Carpenter.
2. **VERIFY/MODIFY/APPROVE MEETING AGENDA:** Motion made by Ed Kazik, second by Don Dahlstrom, to approve the agenda. The motion passed unanimously.
3. **APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:** June 10, 2015. The May minutes will be place on the next agenda for approval. Motion made by Don Dahlstrom, second by Richard Happel to approve the June 10, 2015 minutes as presented. The motion passed unanimously.
4. **COMMITTEE BUSINESS:**
Discussion and Committee recommendations re:
 - A. Sidewalk and right-of-way maintenance/assessment. Given the rapid residential growth of the Village and the new residential subdivisions featuring curb/gutter sidewalks and right-of-way improvements, it is important to vet policies on how ongoing maintenance and future replacement of said features will be handled. The policy should rightly take the form of a uniform and equitably drafted ordinance. Andrew Vickers will bring back a draft of comparables from other communities similar to Hobart.
 - B. Potential practice archery range at Four Seasons Park. A Hobart resident has requested adding a practice archery range at Four Seasons Park. The nearest outdoor archery range is located in Neenah. Andrew Vickers will do more investigation to see if there is enough interest from school groups or clubs in the area. Andrew will also research the liability of adding and archery range to the park.
 - C. Other items brought forth by Committee members or staff. A car lost control on Hwy 29 and went on to the village frontage road, then was able to maneuver and recover without significant damage. There are currently no guardrails between the highway and the frontage road.
The damaged shelter was removed today and we expect to have the new one constructed this fall. The garbage and recycling bins will be picked up from every residence this week from Harter's Fox Valley Disposal. There has been a delay with the delivery of the new bins from Toter. They should be delivered by August 22, 2015. Residents will place their garbage at the curb if they do not have the bins before their regularly scheduled pickup day.
5. **MEETING ADJOURNMENT:** Motion made by Don Dahlstrom, second by Richard Happel, to adjourn. The motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:40pm.
