Groundbreaking Ceremony For New Basketball Training Center Called "The Driveway"

located at 1220 Flightway Dr, near the intersection of Packerland Drive and Grant St. in Hobart. The Driveway will offer summer basketball camps, after school basketball training sessions, small

group and individual training sessions. The Driveway will also host 3 on 3 leagues and tournaments along with coaching clinics. The emphasis will always be on the skill development of the players as well as their

character development. The Driveway will offer rental space for school/club/AAU teams and will be a great destination for birthday parties as well. Ashwaubenon native, and former Green Bay

Phoenix basketball player, Ryan Borowicz, is the owner of The Driveway. He has been conducting basketball camps, and clinics as well as small group and individual sessions for over 10 years. He is one of the

most sought after basketball trainers in the state, having worked with nearly 10,000 kids from 3rd grade through college. The new training center is scheduled for completion in May of 2016.

Pulaski Community School District Community Survey Results Available

The Pulaski Community School District Board of Education announced that results from the superintendent search survey conducted by the district are now available on the district's website. Over 14,000 Pulaski Community School District residents and stakeholders had the opportunity to provide input into the superintendent search process through a survey that

was conducted from November 23-December 13, 2015. In total, 474 surveys were received. "The Board of Education would like to thank the hundreds of community members and district stakeholders who took the time to complete the survey," said board president Robert Skalitzy. "The survey results will be a valuable tool in guiding the board in its search process

and ensuring that it selects the best candidate who reflects the shared values of our district." The application period for the position of district superintendent opened on December 10, 2015. Applications are due January 13, 2016. The Board of Education expects to complete the process and announce its hire on March 2, 2016.
