

Four Seasons Park - Hobart Wisconsin

Four Seasons Park is beautifully situated in northern Hobart on 40 acres and created to enjoy all four seasons. Surrounded by farm fields and rolling hills, it is the home of the Ryan Jerabek Memorial Challenge. The fully enclosed park shelter is heated with a full kitchen, men and women's bathrooms, tables and chairs. An overhang is attached to the building with picnic tables and grills nearby. Playground equipment includes: jungle gym, swings, seesaw and rocking horse.

There are two soccer fields, a baseball diamond, volleyball net and a 1 mile walking trail. Dogs are allowed to accompany their owners if leashed and contained on the trail only.
