



Public Works & Utilities Advisory Committee Minutes
Hobart Village Offices; 2990 S. Pine Tree Rd, Hobart, WI
Tuesday, May 12, 2015- 6:30 pm

1. **CALL TO ORDER; ROLL CALL:** Meeting called to order by Ed Kazik, at 6:30 pm.
Roll call: Ed Kazik, Dave Baranczyk, Richard Happel, and David Smith were present. Keith Sowinski, Tim Carpenter, Don Dahlstrom and Dan Deruyter were excused.
2. **VERIFY/MODIFY/APPROVE MEETING AGENDA:** Motion made by Dave Baranczyk second by Richard Happel, to approve the agenda. Item 4.B was pulled for this meeting. The motion passed unanimously.
3. **APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:** March 10, 2015. MOTION MADE BY Dave Baranczyk, second by Richard Happel, to approve the meeting minutes from March 10, 2015. The motion passed unanimously.
4. **COMMITTEE BUSINESS**
Discussion and Committee recommendations re:
 - A. Review and input on Draft Refuse and Recycling Collection Agreement. Andrew Vickers, Village Administrator, spoke with the group about the Draft agreement. The bin sizes will be standardized at 65 gallon bins for garbage and 95 gallon bins for recycling. The collections will be weekly for both garbage and recycling. During this is a 10 year agreement Advance will repair normal wear & tear on the bins. The Village will be the only point of contact for the residents other than for large material pickups. This will aid in keeping a correct count of bins distributed.
 - B. 5-year Road Plan. This item was taken off of the agenda for this evening's discussion.
 - C. Costs for Guardrail on STH 29/ Centennial Centre Boulevard. The committee once again discussed the guard rail at this location. The DOT will not place one at the site. They say they will allow it but not pay for it as it is not needed. Estimates for a beam guard rail run from \$15.50 per foot to \$22.00 per foot depending upon the need to have a beam on each side of the posts. Discussion on the strength of the rail being the beam side and if the beam is toward our road and someone comes from 29 then there is no strength on just the post side. Mr. Vickers will speak to the Village Board about the double guardrail concept and crash data.
 - D. Other items brought forth by Committee members. There were no other items brought up by the committee members.
5. **MEETING ADJOURNMENT:** Motion made by David Smith, second by Dave Baranczyk, to adjourn. The motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:33pm.
