

State Highway 29 Road Improvements Scheduled to Commence May 26th

The State Department of Transportation is advising the public that road improvement construction on State Highway 29 is scheduled to commence Tuesday, May 26th. Construction activity will take place from the intersection of State Highway 29 and State Highway 156/St. Augustine Rd., to the County J underpass. This project includes concrete pavement joint repairs, localized pavement removal and excavating, asphaltic mill and overlay, culvert pipe liner and replacement, shoulder repairs and restoration, street lighting at the J-turns for improved visibility, beam guard replacement and grading; pavement marking; and sign replacement. The State Highway 29 westbound off-ramp to State Highway 32 will also be reconstructed for turn lane modifications.

The DOT advises that eastbound and westbound traffic will be reduced to one lane of traffic during construction, opening to two lanes Fridays from noon to 8 pm and Sundays from noon to 8 pm. Additionally, some aspects of this work will be performed outside of the regular work day. For example, concrete patching, which is anticipated to commence Monday, June 1st, may start as early as 3 am; and asphalt overlay installation will occur between 5 pm and 5 am, which is anticipated to start Monday, July 6th and continue for 18 working nights. The State Highway 29/32 interchange, including State Highway 32 under State Highway 29, will also be closed for two, one-week periods for concrete joint repairs and asphaltic paving operations.
