A RESOLUTION NAMING EMT INTERNATIONAL AS A RECIPIENT OF THE HOBART VOLUNTEER AWARD

BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF HOBART, WISCONSIN:

WHEREAS, the Village, in endeavoring to acknowledge and honor residents, organizations and businesses who provide a non-compensated service that benefits the Village and its residents, created a Volunteer Award; and

WHEREAS, on December 15th 2021, a domestic violence incident resulted in a difficult and trying situation for the Hobart-Lawrence Police Department, as well as the neighboring residents; and,

WHEREAS, upon noticing the large response from the Hobart-Lawrence Police Department, as well as other surrounding agencies, Paul Rauscher, owner of EMT International, was quick to act and offered his business to law enforcement as a staging area and eventual command post, providing a warm and secure area; and,

WHEREAS, a large conference room was used for command operations, another meeting room was used for negotiations away from all the hectic traffic of officers responding, and a third room, the training room, was used as a breakroom and lunchroom for the officers; and


WHEREAS, during the entire time that the incident was happening, Paul provided endless soda, water, coffee to anyone who wanted it, and, at his own expense, went out and purchased lunches and, with the help of his employees, brought them back for the officers; and,

WHEREAS, while a large number of EMT International employees provided assistance and support, two in particular, Mark Weber and Connie Fink, were outstanding in providing help throughout the entire day. Connie stayed after her normal work hours and assisted Police Chief Randy Bani with talking to and comforting the victim of the domestic violence incident, and helping Chief Bani with the notification of the victim's boyfriend's passing; and,

WHEREAS, the generosity and comfort provided by EMT International and its staff was very much appreciated by all law enforcement personnel involved in this tragic incident;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board of the Village of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin, does hereby name EMT International and its employees as a Hobart Volunteer Award recipient for their caring support of our local law enforcement on December 15th 2021, and do hereby acknowledge and appreciate their service.
