



ORDINANCE 2022-16

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HOBART, SPECIFICALLY SECTION 3 (PENALTIES) OF ARTICLE II (GENERAL PENALTY) OF CHAPTER 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS)

Purpose: The purpose of this Ordinance is to remove the imprisonment of any person who has an unpaid fine or forfeiture from the penalty clause of the Municipal Code.

The Village Board of the Village of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1: Section 3 (Penalties) of Article II (General Penalty) of Chapter 1 (General Provisions) of the Code of the Village of Hobart, is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 1-3. Penalties.

A. Standard penalty. Unless another penalty is expressly provided by the Code for any particular provision, section or chapter, any person violating any provision of this Code or any rule or regulation adopted or issued in pursuance thereof, or any provision of any code adopted here by reference shall, upon conviction, be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$20 nor more than \$10,000 and the cost of prosecution.

B. Each day a violation. Each act of violation, and every day upon which a violation occurs or continues, constitutes a separate offense.

C. Applicability. The penalty provided by this section and/or any section of this Code applies to the amendment of any section of this Code and any code adopted herein by reference to which the penalty relates whether or not such penalty is reenacted in the amendatory ordinances, unless otherwise provided in the amendment.

D. Reference to sections. Reference to any section of this Code shall be understood also to refer to and include the penalty section relating thereto, unless otherwise expressly provided.

E. Failure of officers to perform duties. The failure of any officer or employee of the Village to perform any official duty imposed by this Code shall not subject such officer or employee to the penalty imposed for violation of this Code, unless a penalty is specifically provided.

F. Bond schedule, non-traffic violations. The Bond Schedule for non-traffic violations shall be as set forth in Chapter 14, Citations.

G. Court authority to impose alternative juvenile dispositions and sanctions.

(1) For a juvenile adjudged to have violated an ordinance, a court is authorized to impose any of the dispositions listed in §§ 938.343 and 938.344, Wis. Stats., in accordance with the provisions of those statutes.


(2) For a juvenile adjudged to have violated an ordinance who violates a condition of a dispositional order of the court under § 938.343 or 938.344, Wis. Stats., the municipal court is authorized to impose any of the sanctions listed in § 938.355(6)(d), Wis. Stats., in accordance with the provisions of those statutes.

(3) This section is enacted under the authority of § 938.17(2)(cm), Wis. Stats.

Section 2: Any Ordinance or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be published as required by law after passage by the Village Board.
